

Alan Shields collaborated with Kenneth Tyler, Rodney Konopaki, Kim Halliday, Lee Funderburg and the staff of Tyler Graphics Ltd. from December 1977 to December 1979 to create this series of nine prints. For eight of the prints, the artist designed unique colored handmade papers. The project employed the techniques of lino-cut, intaglio, hand stamping and screen printing with sewing, silver leaf and collage elements.

Each print is signed, numbered and titled in pencil by the artist and bears the chopmark of the workshop.
