

Make a 'chatterbox' guessing game to use in the exhibition

Instructions on folding

- With the coloured side down, fold over each corner to the centre point (crease along the lines).
- Turn the folded paper over.
- Fold each corner to the centre.
- Fold the square in half, then in half again, to make creases.
- Using two hands, place thumbs and index fingers under the coloured flaps.

How to play 'chatterbox' guessing game

- This is a game for two players. Ask your friend to pick one of the coloured squares

 for example 'soot'.
- Open and close the game in alternate directions for each letter of the word 'soot'.
- Ask your friend to choose one of the four words for example 'pattern'.
- Open and close the game in alternate directions again for each letter of the new word.
- Ask your friend to choose another word, open the flap and see if they can answer the question.
