

GAME OF CHANCE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SUMMARY

- 1. This promotion is conducted, and the prize is administered by the National Gallery of Australia ABN: 27 855 975 449, Parkes Place East, Parkes, Kamberri/Canberra ACT 2600 AUSTRALIA ("Promoter").
- 2. This promotion is a game of chance. It is free to enter, and each eligible entry has an equal chance of winning.
- 3. All entry instructions and prize information published by the Promoter form part of these Terms and Conditions. Entry to the promotion constitutes acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

PARTICIPATION

- 1. Entries open from 5pm ACT local time on 1 November 2022 and close at 11:59pm ACT local time on 14 November 2022 ("Promotion Period").
- 2. Employees of the Promoter are ineligible to enter the promotion, as are their immediate families.
- 3. To enter the promotion, an entrant must have completed the National Engagement Plan survey conducted by the Promotor and elected to enter the prize draw by providing their name and email address during the Promotion Period.
- 4. An entrant's submission must not be late, incomplete, incomprehensible or in violation of any of the Promotor's policies or any laws.
- 5. Entry to the promotion is limited to one (1) entry per person.
- 6. If there is a dispute as to the identity or eligibility of an entrant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity or eligibility of the entrant or the validity of an entry. In the event that the winner cannot provide suitable proof of eligibility, they will forfeit the prize and no substitution or compensation will be offered.
- 7. Entries are deemed to be received at the time of receipt by the Promoter (not the time of transmission). The Promoter takes no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries or for delays or failures in any telecommunications services or equipment.
- 8. The Promoter may, in its absolute discretion, declare an entry to be invalid if that entry has not been submitted in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or where the entrant has engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise the fair and proper conduct of the promotion.

<u>Winner</u>

- 1. An entrant is eligible to win the prize if they are 16 years old and over and a resident of Australia.
- There will be two (2) winners. The winners will be randomly drawn by the Promotor at the National Gallery of Australia, Parkes Place East, Parkes ACT at 4pm ACT local time on 30 November 2022. Participants can attend the draw, but they are not required to do so in order to win a prize.
- 3. The winners will be notified via email within five (5) working days of the judge's decision and published on the National Gallery website.
- 4. All reasonable attempts will be made to contact the winners and deliver the prizes. However, if the prize is not claimed by 13 January 2023, it will be redrawn, and the winner of an unclaimed prize will be notified via email.

PRIZE

- 1. Each winner will win one (1) Cressida Campbell prize pack valued at \$200 and consisting of:

 - b. Cressida Campbell exhibition notebook
 - c. Cressida Campbell 54 piece playing cards
 - d. Tote Japanese Hydrangea
- 2. The Promoter will, at the Promoter's cost, post the prize to the winner's postal address within 28 days of the winner claiming the prize.
