EXHIBITION OVERVIEW

The year 2021 marks one hundred years since the birth of acclaimed Australian artist Jeffrey Smart. To celebrate and commemorate this significant centenary, the National Gallery will hold a major exhibition of his work.

Smart is one of the most celebrated Australian artists of the 20th century. Seeking inspiration from the world around him, he looked to the environment of urban and industrial modernity such as apartment blocks, factories, modes of transport, highways, and signage – all of which he rendered with a sense of theatre and an intimate understanding of geometry and composition. These potent images have become emblematic of 20th and 21st century urban experience. Building on the foundational work already undertaken on Smart, this exhibition will bring fresh perspectives to his artistic contribution so that his remarkable legacy will be kept alive in the present.

Much of Jeffrey Smart's work draws inspirations from three pivotal locations where he spent most of his life: his hometown of Adelaide; Sydney, where he established his career; and his adopted country of Italy, where he lived from 1964 until his death in 2013.

The exhibition will feature some of Jeffrey Smart's most famous works, including *Labyrinth* (2011), *Self portrait*, *Procida* (1950-51) and *Wallaroo* (1951).

HOW TO PURCHASE STEP 1


Jeffrey Smart wholesale vouchers are available to purchase via the Gallery website. To begin you will need to apply for a wholesale account by emailing tourism@nga.gov.au

Please allow up to three days to receive your promo code.

STEP 2

Go to: https://connect.nga.gov.au/jswholesale

Put your specific promo code in the top right section. Each time you would like to purchase additional vouchers, you can use the same log in and promo code. You will be prompted to set up an account. Multiple accounts can be created, as long as the same promo code is used.

^{*}Refunds are not available.


^{*}Children under 5 are free, and do not need vouchers purchased for them.

STEP 3

Voucher prices for your organisation will appear.

Once you have finalised your purchase, the vouchers will be emailed to you in PDF form, which you can then distribute to your guests. Each voucher is on its own page and has a unique code, so we recommend recording which vouchers have been distributed.

REFUND POLICY

Please note every sale is final and there are NO refunds on any wholesale vouchers purchased for *Jeffrey Smart*. Please take care when ordering and ensure you are only ordering according to your requirements.

HOW TO REDEEM

Jeffrey Smart is a timed entry exhibition with COVID-19 safe capacity limits, however, wholesale vouchers are not timed or dated. To redeem vouchers for tickets, guests will have two options:

1. ONLINE PRIOR TO VISIT:

Provide your guest/s with the redemption form, here. Guest/s can identify their preferred date and time by completing the form and submitting it at least 3 business days prior to the intended visit date. Our Visitor Experience team will email guest/s with Jeffrey Smart timed entry tickets and general entry tickets to Gallery.

On arrival, guest/s can scan their general entry tickets with Gallery staff or the self-scanners, and their Jeffrey Smart tickets at the exhibition entrance.

2. ON THE DAY OF VISIT:

Guest/s can call on the day of visit to confirm availability of preferred time session prior to their arrival. Tickets will not be guaranteed until arrival at preferred session (subject to availability). At this point, guests can redeem the wholesale voucher PDF at the Gallery ticketing desk and will be allocated into the next available session.

Jeffrey Smart exhibition tickets include free timed entry access to the rest of the Gallery.

If a guest with an allocated wholesale entry voucher cancels an accommodation package, please email information@nga.gov.au with the wholesale voucher number, reference letter, order number and reference number. The allocated entry voucher will be cancelled and a new voucher will be provided. Vouchers cannot be reissued if the ticket has already been redeemed.
