Free Age Range:

Children aged 4 years and under are entitled to enter the exhibition at no charge, while accompanied by a paying adult. Both Member and Non-member.

Additional Free Range:

- When accompanied by a National Gallery Member, children aged up to 16 years are entitled to enter the exhibition at no charge. A maximum of 3 children per Member entry applies.

- Council of Australasian Museum Directors - CAMD
- Teachers and Educators accompanying a school group are free.

Free teacher to student ratios are 1:15 or 1:8 for early childhood learning.

Companion Card:

The National Gallery supports the Companion Card program and agrees to provide an admission ticket for the cardholder's companion at no charge when the cardholder's ticket is purchased at the same time. Carers in a caring capacity are eligible to enter at no charge.
