


Let's create our own

FLAGS FOR BEDROOM NATIONS




Use a large sheet of paper, an old pillowcase or a t-shirt as your flag. Decorate with markers or coloured paper.

Start with small thumbnail drawings to plan what you will include and why.




4 to 5
